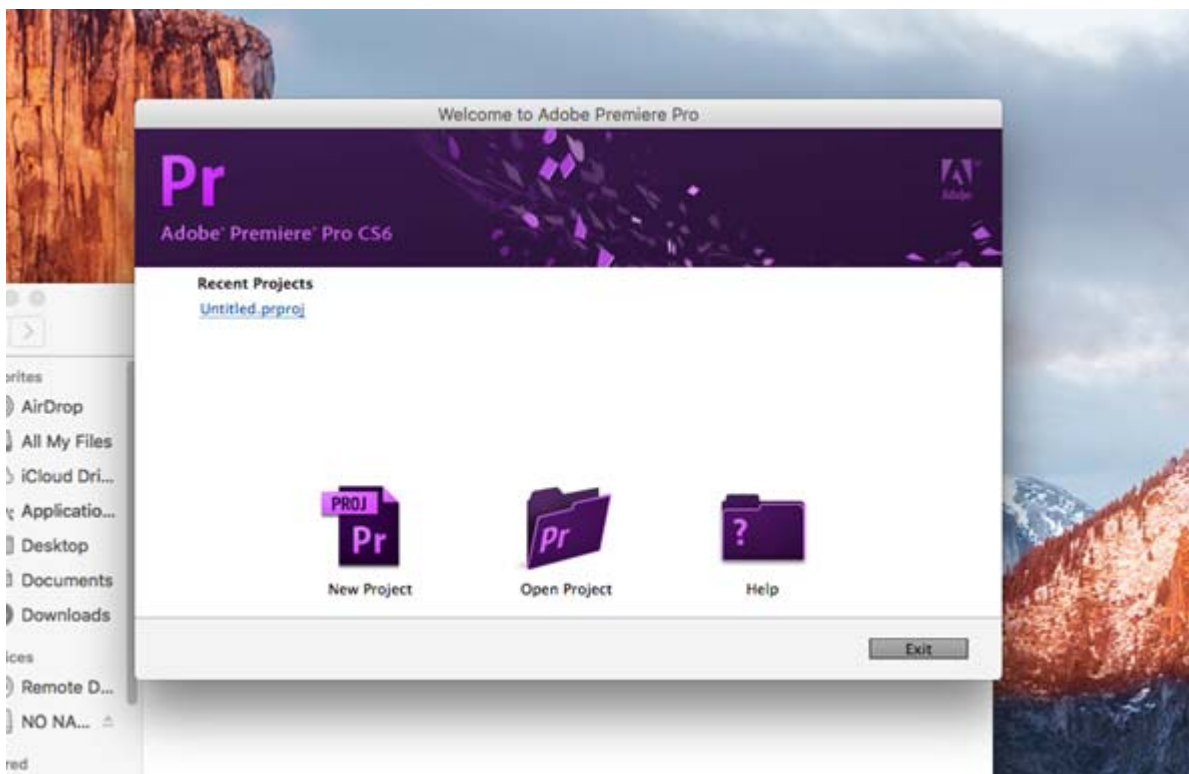


INSTRUCTION FOR CREATING A PROJECT IN PREMEIRE PRO CS6

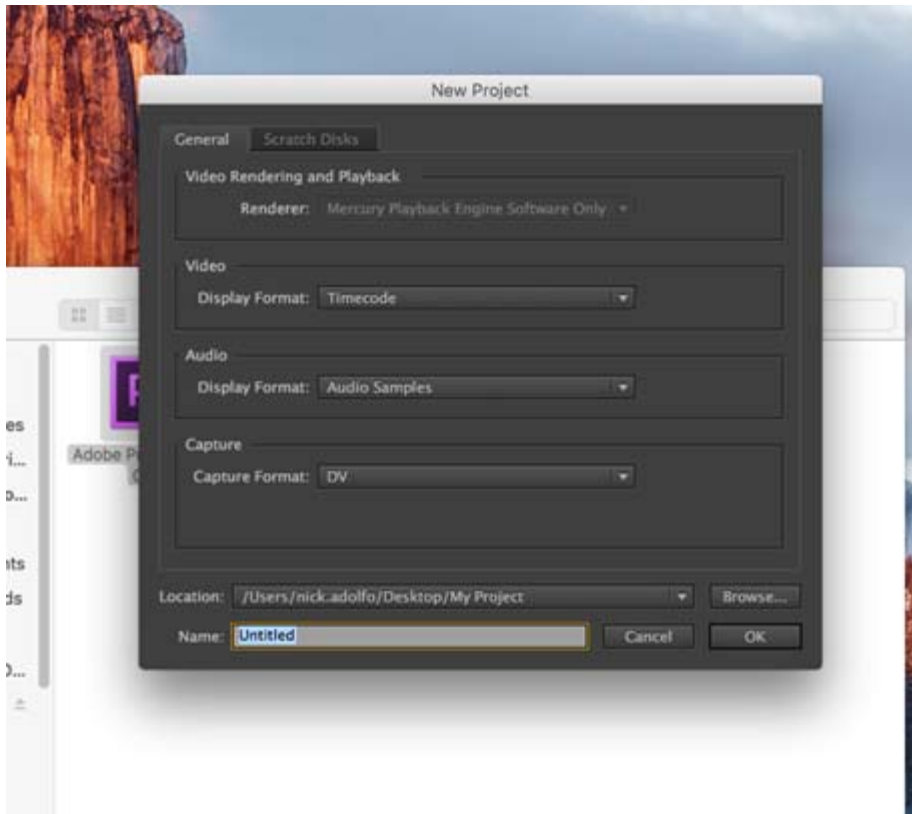
1. Create a folder on the desktop of the computer. Name it after your project. Copy all the clips for your project into this folder. Also, you should copy any other files that you download into this folder before you import them into Adobe Premiere.



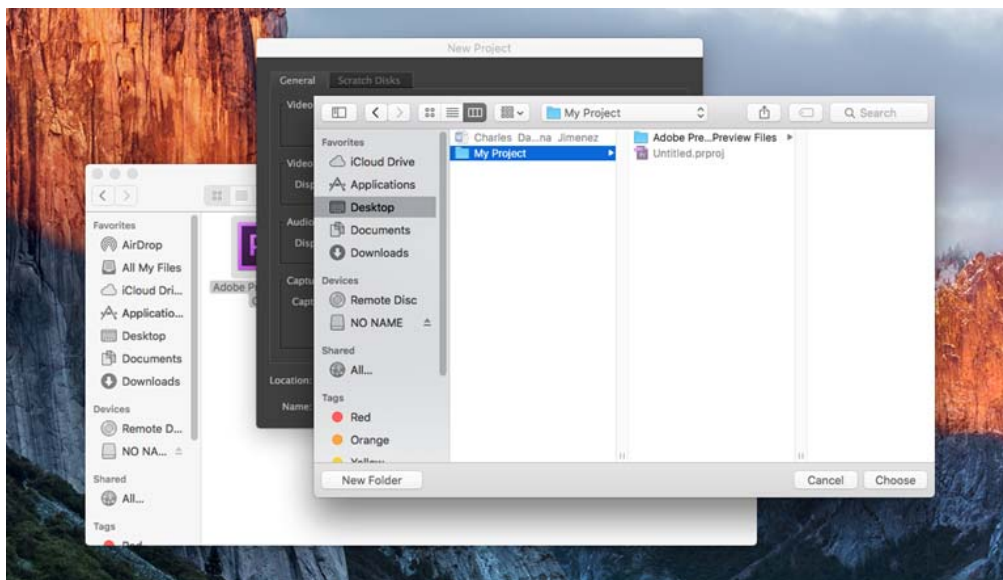
2. Open Adobe Premiere by going to the Applications folder and double clicking on the icon. You will get a screen like the one in the screen image below. Click on “New Project.”



3. Clicking “New Project” in the previous step will open a dialogue box like the one below. You will now create a project file.

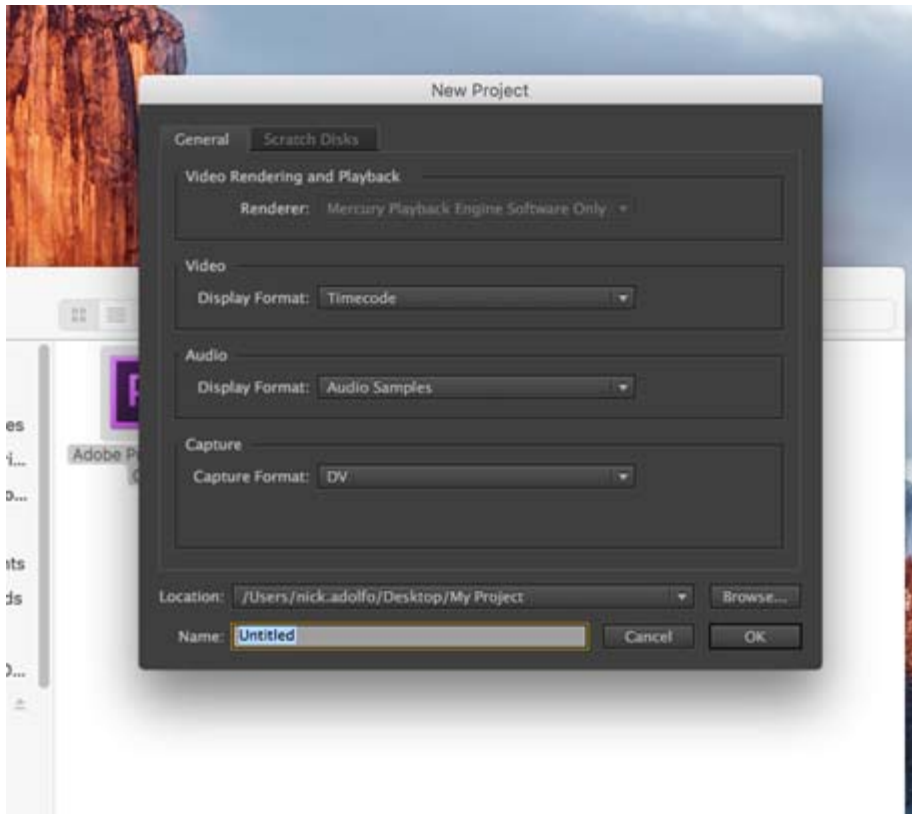


Click on “Browse” and find the project folder you created in step 1.

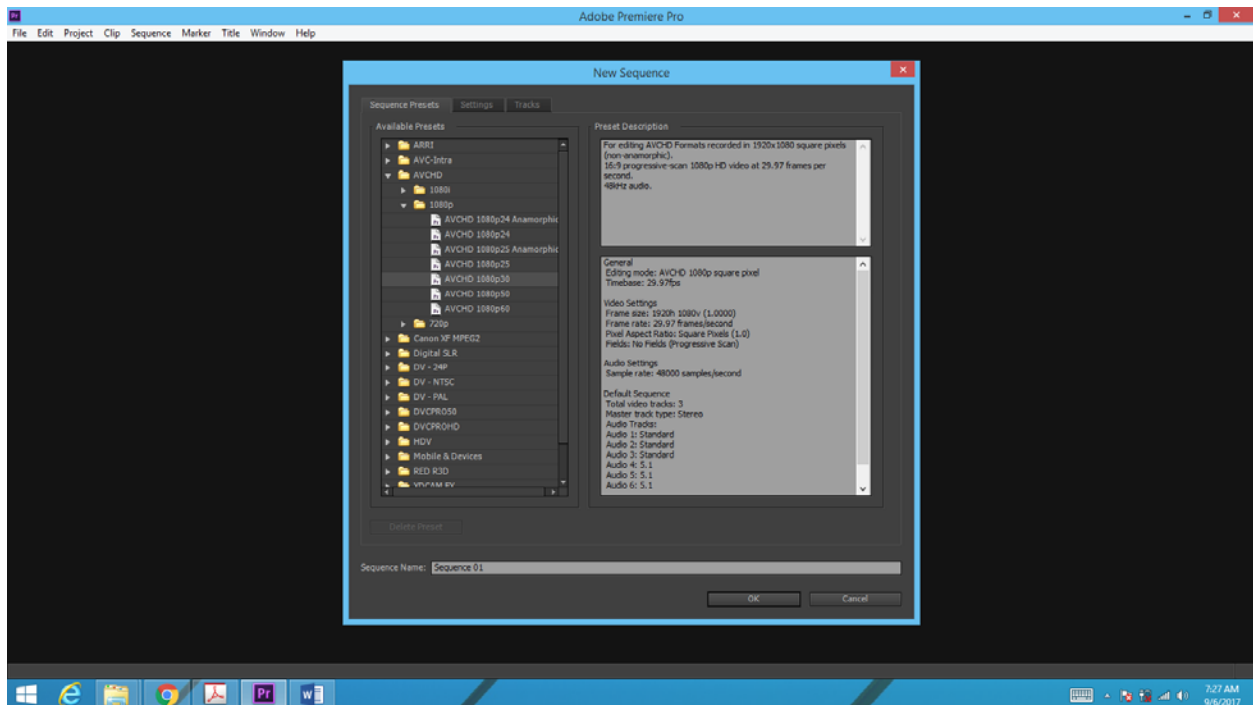


Click “Choose” and Adobe Premiere will create your project file in that folder.

Fill in “Name:” with the name of your movie, then click OK.



4. You will then be asked to select a format for your movie. The format we work in is AVCHD, 1080p30. The 30 refers to 30 frames per second.



5. Premiere will now open completely and you are ready to import your media files from your project folder.
